

## Garment Designer 2.5.4 Mac Installation:

1. View the files on the CD.
2. Open Finder window and copy the Garment Designer folder to *Applications*.
3. Double-click on the **Sentinel\_Runtime.dmg** file to open the Sentinel Runtime window and install. (this is the driver for the USB Hasp Key)
4. If you already have a driver on your system, double-click on the *Uninstall Sentinel Runtime Environment* icon to remove the old driver.
5. Then, double-click on the *Install Sentinel Runtime Environment* icon to install the new driver.
4. Plug the USB key into your computer. (Don't plug the key in the computer until you have installed both GD and the HASP drivers!). The key should light up, and now you can open Garment Designer.

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### **Note:**

Some Mac computers are set up with restricted 'permissions' on programs installed in the *Applications* folder. This means that you cannot write to that folder. When you save a custom sloper, you are asking to write to a file to the *Cochenille Data* folder inside the *Garment Designer 2.5.4* folder, so you will not be allowed.

### **Solution?** There are two.

1. Change the permissions to allow you to write to the Garment Designer 2.5.4 folder and the Cochenille Data folder inside (click once on the folder and use File>Get Info to do this)

OR

2. Move the *Garment Designer 2.5.4* folder outside of the *Applications* folder.
